
I am encouraged to report we finally seem to be making progress with the Point Betsie road end project. As you know, the condition of the road has been a continuing challenge for ease of visitor parking and safety of pedestrians. As of the time of this letter, the Friends, the Benzie County Parks and Recreation Commission, and the Benzie County Road Commission have agreed to a conceptual plan. The next step is to seek concurrence from the appropriate State agencies prior to making application for a funding grant. A public hearing will be scheduled for early December, which will be publicized in the Record Patriot. This process takes time, but if all goes well construction could begin as early as the fall of 2018. We don't have a final cost estimate for the project yet, but you can expect us to launch a fund raising appeal next year to help raise the required matching funds for the grant.

This is my final message as President of the Friends. We should all be very proud of what we have been able to accomplish together over the past four years. I particularly wish to thank the members of our Board, our wonderful volunteers, and all of you who have supported our efforts since the beginning. I am confident the light at Point Betsie will shine for generations to come.

#### A FUNDRAISER 'ŴITH A TWIST'

More than 250 people gathered on a sunny day in early August to celebrate Point Betsie Lighthouse and the protected land that surrounds it.

"The Intersection of Art and Nature" included lighthouse tours, local food and beverages, live music, and a special opportunity to create a painting of the lighthouse, thanks to Traverse City's "Painting with a Twist."

The Aug. 2 event was the first joint fundraiser held by the Friends of Point Betsie Lighthouse and the Nature Conservancy, which works to preserve the freshwater dunes system. Proceeds supported preservation efforts at the lighthouse and its grounds, including enhancements to an exhibit about the work of the Conservancy, according to Jim Radabaugh, president of the Lighthouse Board of Directors.

"People know of our mission to preserve the building and artifacts at Point Betsie, and our commitment to educate the visiting public on the historic significance of this local landmark. They are generally not as familiar with our commitment to promote stewardship of the lakeshore, watershed, and local environment," said Radabaugh. "The Friends have had a natural partnership with the Nature Conservancy since our inception. We saw an opportunity here to forge partnerships with other local non-profit organizations in an effort to build a stronger overall community."

Many thanks to all our volunteers, and to Frankz in Frankfort for providing such delicious food for our guests. Live music was provided by Floyd & Them Other Pluckers - What a great event!!

#### ROAD END/PARKING PROJECT

As Jim discussed, we're moving forward on the road end/parking project in cooperation with Benzie County Parks & Recreation and Road Commission. We have also kept the neighbors updated and they have contributed to the discussion. We will soon bring Lake Township into the process. Right now we're focused on getting the conceptual plan and other pertinent details finalized and conducting a Public Hearing in preparation for a large dollar grant application to address much of the funding for the project. The deadline for the grant is April 1, 2017 with grant-awarding not being made until late November of 2017 and finalized in early Spring 2018. Hence, project construction will not occur until after the 2018 open season. We have already communicated with the granting agency and we believe we are highly competitive to be considered for a grant.

Obtaining a grant for this high-dollar project will be necessary for construction but will not cover the entire cost. Grants require matching funds as with our prior renovation projects. The Friends have accumulated a reserve over the years to address the remaining capital projects, but depending on the eventual cost, we will need to raise substantial additional funds to be ready to start. We are hopeful of partnering with other agencies for the matching funds as the road end serves more than just the Lighthouse. The Road Commission would also like to resurface the rest of Point Betsie Road if that can come together. We are heartened that long needed improvements and safety considerations are on the horizon for Point Betsie Road.
